

AHEC Community Health Scholars Program

What is the AHEC Scholars Program?

The AHEC Community Health Scholars Program is a 2-year program that enables high-potential graduate-level MSW, MPH, and undergraduate students (junior standing) in a health-related field to explore primary care with an emphasis on community health and interdisciplinary practice in medically underserved communities.

Who is eligible?

- Masters level MPH/MSW students.
- Undergraduate students in a health-related field (must be in your junior year).
- List of approved majors: Masters of Social Work (2 years), Community Health Worker, Community Mental Health Worker, Dentistry, Health Education Specialist, Medical Assistant, Psychology, and Public Health.

What are the program requirements?

- Complete a minimum of 50 hours of didactic learning per year, provided by CCALAC through monthly trainings.
- Complete a minimum of 250 hours of experiential learning at a CCALAC member clinic.
 - Clinic placement is facilitated by CCALAC program coordinator
