Central Valley Health Network is comprised of 15 Community Health Center corporations designated as a Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs). CVHN was established to conduct advocacy at national, state, and local levels on behalf of it's Central Valley membership of FQHC's and their unique patient population specific to the Valley. CVHN's members are located in, and serving, high-need communities throughout California's greater Central Valley, they provide comprehensive primary health care services to low-income and medically underserved families.

CVHN is one of California's AHEC, or Area Health Education Centers. In our role as an AHEC, we provide a variety of learning and professional development opportunities across the spectrum of the health center workforce. To support these efforts, CVHN partners with its members on the following initiatives:

- Community Health Fellowship and AmeriCorps Public health programs that provide public health training to both young adults, and local community members.
